

Employer Fact Sheet: Apprenticeship Funding in Wales

The Welsh government incentive funding is now available to all employers based in Wales, who employ apprentices between 1st August 2020 and 28th February 2021, or until all the allocated funding is claimed.

The funding is split into categories depending on apprentice age and how many contracted hours that they are employed for.

If you employ an apprentice between 16-24yrs of age* you receive:

£3000 if the learner is employed at least 30 hours

£1500 if the learner is employed 16-29 hours

If you employ an apprentice 25yrs old or older* you receive:

£2000 if the learner is employed at least 30 hours

£1000 if the learner is employed 16-29 hours

**If a learner is self-declared disabled and therefore requires additional support or equipment, there is also an additional £1500 available.*

Haddon Training will apply for the incentives on your behalf.

50% will be paid after approximately 3 months on programme, and the remaining 50% will be paid as the learner approaches the end of the apprenticeship, as per the government's instructions.

Additional Requirements

The government have stated that in all cases, to be eligible to receive the above funding, the apprentice **MUST HAVE** a contract start date that matches the start date of the apprenticeship.

There is a limit of a maximum of 10 apprentices per employer.

Standard eligibility requirements apply - these will be assessed by Haddon Training in advance of the apprenticeship beginning, and we can advise on these on a case-by-case basis.
